how to take care of your new tattoo

AFTERCARE REMINDERS

DO...

- Leave your bandage on for up to 5 days
- Gently remove bandage in the shower
- Keep it clean with non scented soap
- Always air dry or paper towel pat dry
- Apply lotion when area becomes itchy
- Ice your tattoo & drink plenty of water
- Slap the tattoo if itchy
- Keep it protected under your clothing
- Show all your friends and family!
- Send your artist healed pictures!

DONT...

- Do not rip your bandage off
- Do not expose your tattoo to prolonged water activities
(ie. Swimming, hot tubs)
- Do not scratch or pick the tattoo
- DO NOT OVER WASH IT
- DO NOT OVER LOTION IT
- Do not expose to sun or tanning
- Do not expose to animals

ASK IF....

- You develop a reaction or redness
- You experience tenderness
- Your tattoo takes too long to heal
- You experience severe bruising
- You see fluid coming from the area
- You have any questions
- You need a touch up
- Your bandage falls off early
- We have time to book your next piece!

IT'S NORMAL...

- To have some soreness
- A build up of fluid in the bandage
- To feel tight and stiff in the area
- TO HAVE A GREAT NIGHT'S SLEEP
- To feel very drained afterwards
- To get tons of new compliments
- To be stopped on the street by strangers
- To feel much more confident about yourself and who you are!

STRETCH WRAP

HOW TO REMOVE ZOOTATTOO® STRETCH WRAP

When to Remove

- Remove the application after 3-5 days.
- If bleeding is excessive, remove the wrap earlier, clean the tattoo with a soft soap, and apply a new wrap once the tattoo has settled.

How to Remove

- Slowly peel the wrap back over itself rather than pulling it upward to minimize discomfort.
- For easier removal, soak the wrap with warm water or apply a gentle oil (like coconut oil) to loosen it.

Additional Tips

- **While Bathing:** Remove the wrap during a warm bath or shower to make the process smoother. Use warm, soapy water to help dissolve the adhesive.
- **Excessive Bleeding:** If you notice seepage due to bleeding, remove the wrap, clean the area thoroughly, and reapply once settled.
- **Pets:** Avoid contact with pets during the healing process to reduce the risk of contamination.

Healing Tips

- Keep the wrap as dry as possible during use. Prolonged exposure to water is not recommended.
- Stay hydrated and eat well to support optimal healing.

Important Notes

- Use only as directed.
- Do not apply to infected skin.
- If you experience irritation or a burning sensation, remove the wrap and clean the tattoo with ZOOTATTOO® WASH, a gentle soap or natural Castile soap.
- Discontinuing use due to an allergic reaction will not harm your tattoo.
- If symptoms persist, consult your health practitioner.
